NOTICE OF RACE

- 1. **Rules:** This regatta will be governed by the current edition of the Racing Rules of Sailing, the requirements of the Thistle Class Association, the current Severn Sailing Association Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions, as amended, and this Notice of Race.
- Sailing Instructions: Paper copies of the Sailing Instructions, including any amendments, will be available at Registration Saturday morning. The SSA Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions is available online at <u>www.severnsailing.org</u> under Racing. Amendments to the SSA NoR/SI will be available on the online registration page.

3. Eligibility and Entry:

- This regatta is open to all R&D Thistle Class boats. Current membership in the Thistle Class Association is required for all skippers.
- Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form (available at <u>www.severnsailing.org</u>) and paying the required fee, no later than 2 hours before the boat's first scheduled warning signal.
- 4. Fees: \$70 / \$80 after October 4
 - The entry fee includes racing, continental breakfasts each day, and appetizers Saturday evening.

5. Schedule:

Awards to Follow

• The number of races each day may vary as weather conditions permit. The total number of races for the regatta shall not exceed seven (7); one (1) completed race shall constitute a regatta.

6. Communication:

- Competitors may receive courtesy VHF radio transmissions from the Race Committee over VHF channel 65a (or as announced) concerning safety, notice of on-course-side (OCS) boats and general information to assist in the management of the event. The use of any other electronic communication devices, including cellular phones, is prohibited except in an emergency.
- Except in an emergency, a participating boat shall neither make nor receive radio communications not available to all participating boats.
- 7. Venue: The racing area will be in the Chesapeake Bay, near the mouth of the Severn River.
- 8. Penalty System: RSS/US Appendix V1 and V2 shall be in effect. This modifies SSA NoR/SSI 17.1.
- 9. Scoring:
 - A boat's regatta score shall be the total of her race scores.
 - A minimum of one completed race will constitute a regatta.
- 10. Prizes: Prizes will be awarded to skippers and crew placing first, second, and third in the regatta.

- **COVID 19:** All participants and their guests are expected to follow CDC, State of Maryland, Thistle Class Association, and Severn Sailing Association guidance as appropriate.
