- 1100 Warning Signal for racing, subsequent races to follow. No race will be started after 1500 on Sunday. The Awards presentation will be as soon as possible following final race.
- Racing Area: Because we will be racing with the Pride FJ Fleet will be racing closer to SSA, most likely in the Carr Creek area.
- **6. Courses:** The courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions.
- 7. Scoring: The regatta will be scored on up to five races using the low point scoring system. The plan is to have up to six races to allow for a throw out. One race is sufficient to constitute a series.
- **8. Awards**: Prizes will be awarded to the Skipper and crew for the top three finishers.
- 9. Radio Communications:
 - · Competitors may use VHF radios for safety.
 - VHF channels will be announced at the Skippers Meeting.
